

## Apple Games



Below is a list of other games you might like to play which are all about apples...

### **Apple Tasting**

Buy a selection of different apples and cut them into pieces. Ask the children to eat a piece of each apple and then describe how they taste. They could also vote on which apple tasted the best and come up with a class favourite. Perhaps this could be offered in the school canteen.

### **Feely bag Fruit**

For this activity you will need some cloth bags, or trays with a piece of cloth over them. The idea is to place different fruit in the bag (or on the tray) and the children must work out what the fruit is just by feeling them. Encourage the children to describe what they can feel before they guess. You could also play this game by blindfolding the children if you do not have cloth bags or trays. Alternatively, you could get the children to smell the different fruit - can they tell which is which?

### **Apple puzzles**

Print out the attached pictures onto card. Cut them into pieces for the children to use as puzzles. The more pieces, the more difficult the puzzle.

### **Apple printing**

This is similar to potato printing, but using apples instead. Cut the apples open and then cut different shapes into their surface. The children can then dip them in paint and use them to create their own apple art!
